Pastor's Corner

I know things have been tense for a while in the world, but it feels like things are more tense than they've ever been, at least for the past few years: War in Ukraine, Election season, ramping up of tension between China and Taiwan, a sagging economy, winter. I know life isn't made any easier by any of these things. It's hard to wonder how much your money will pay for gas and food, and while we aren't in harm's way from war, we certainly feel it in our checkbooks when the prices of goods go up. Add in the election and it feels like things can't get any crazier.

In this moment, I'm reminded of a verse from the book of Esther in the Old Testament. In it, Esther's cousin Mordecai is speaking to her when her courage wanes. Esther has the potential to step up and speak for her people and do the right thing, but is scared to face the king. Mordecai encourages her, though he is the one being threatened and she safe in the palace. "Who knows? Perhaps you have come to royal dignity for just such a time as this." (4:14, NRSV)

With the encouragement, Esther does face the king, and saves her own people from slaughter. She does not let her fear control her, and instead, chooses to use the position she's been put in for the sake of God's people.

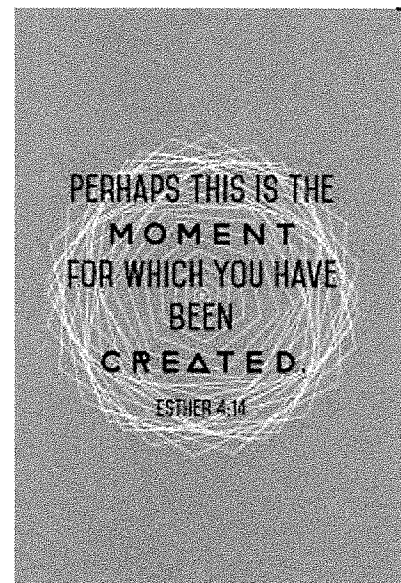
We are in a similar situation now. Things may seem rather anxious and out of our control, but that is not so. We have learned from Jesus that even the smallest ministry matters. The ministry of the Church started out as 12 people, going around to towns, preaching, healing and casting out demons. Compared to the rule of the Roman Empire, these actions meant very little. But, those ministries were not small to the people they encouraged, healed, and saved.

We too have come to a time such as this. God has given us a role to play in this time of anxiety: to speak and act in love in a world of hate and violence, to show that life goes on and God is still the ruler of all no matter what the elections say, to give what we can to help the least of these, and to bring the warmth of community to all those in search of it in winter.

It is comforting to know that we have these ministries. It shows that despite how bad the world looks and feels, God is not done with us yet. It gives us something to focus on other than ourselves and any worry we may have. So, if you're feeling the weight of everything happening in the world on you right now, think about the small things you can do – the love that God calls us to, and the choices we make that may not seem to matter much now, but makes all the difference to the kingdom of God.

May this month be filled with peace and blessings from our Lord Jesus Christ.

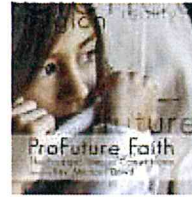

Spark is for 9th-12th graders and meets 5-7 pm. Much

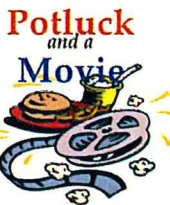

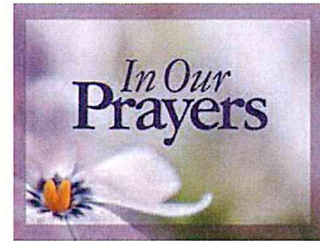

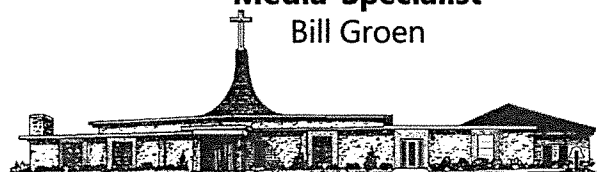
